

Sending a Message to a Classmate via Class Website

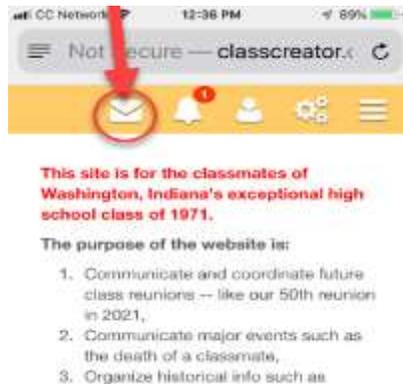

You may someday want to contact a classmate but don't have their phone number or email address. Turns out our class website can help.

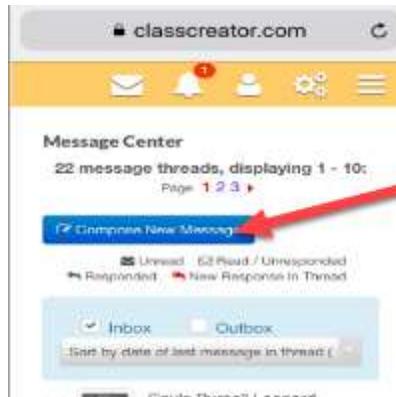
This works only if 1) the classmate has joined the website, and 2) still uses a computer/phone to check email and/or log on our class website. If not, they won't see your class website message.

Here is a quick tutorial on how to send a message to a classmate via our class website.

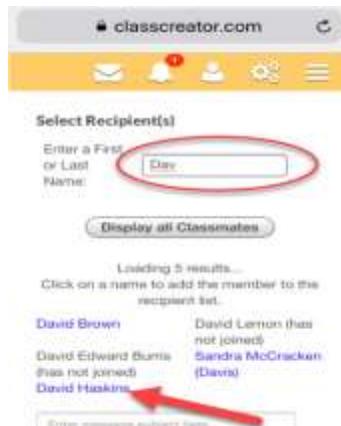
1. After signing in to our class website, click the "letter" icon at the top part of the home page.



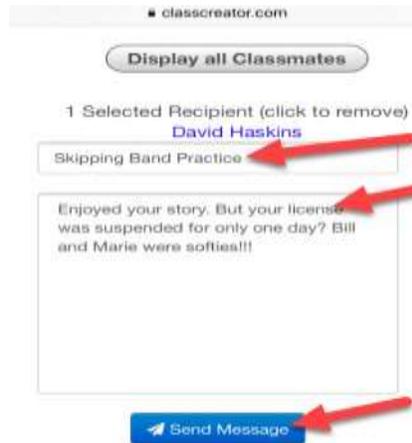
2. Click the "Compose New Message" blue button.



3. Type the classmate's name. Then click the classmate's name when it appears in the results.



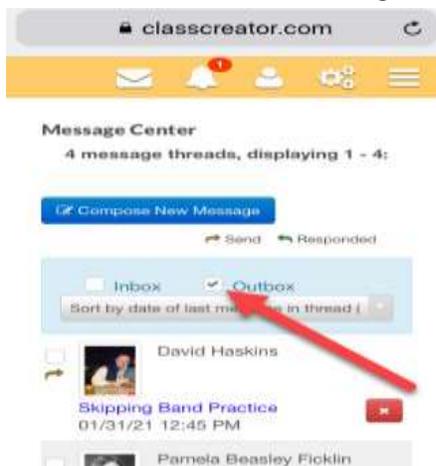
- Next type the “Subject” and then your message. When ready, click the “Send Message” button.



- After clicking “Send Message”, you will see a confirmation the message was sent. Note the “Inbox” and “Outbox” check boxes. They control if you see your incoming or outgoing messages.



- Click the “Outbox” box to see your outgoing messages, which includes the “Skipping Band Practice” from our example. Click the “Inbox” to see messages sent to you from classmates.
